




The Goal

Connection













Arrows symbolize progress, forwardthinking, and overcoming challenges like COVID. Arrows pointing toward each other represent the connections forged in workplace relationships.








LEVEL 3 FLOOR PLAN






LEVEL 3 RENDERED FLOOR PLAN











MEZZANINE FLOOR PLAN
